PACT Information

The PACT registration option allows you to take your TExES content exam prior to admission to WCACP.

- ✓ Limited to 5 tries per content exam
 - ✓ You can test in any certification area WCACP offers – no experience or college credits needed
 - ✓ If you fail a PACT exam, you have to wait 45 days to retest in the same content area
 - ✓ If you fail a PACT exam, you can switch to another content area. Switching exams will allow you to test faster.
 - ✓ Each PACT attempt is \$116, paid to the Pearson testing directly
